(2) Different walks of life - Individual, Family, workplace, society, nation and the world

→ (3) problem and solution

→ concept, history and current status followed by benefits, problems and solution

Eg:- PPP, Globalization, Economic reforms, Judicial activism

(4) Sectoral: Social, political, Economical, Administrative, international, Environmental, Historical, Scientific, Security and legal.

→ For suggestions - futuristic tone

point ~~wise~~ wise - First, second, third... Last,

→ Conclude Rhetoric passage

- Poem or shloka
- Futuristic vision - use catch phrases  
refer preamble, DPSP, vision of  
the makers of modern India
- quote

→ ~~Quote~~

- Echo - if started from anecdote,  
refer back to the same with  
futuristic tone

→ Flow - Try to connect each sentence  
with previous ones

→ unifying idea in each paragraph

→ Transitioning between the paragraphs:-

① Through linking sentence - end <sup>sentence</sup> of  
the last paragraph with next para.

② By asking question - end the last  
paragraph with question and continue  
the next paragraph with answer

③ Politically, Economically, etc

→ One paragraph one idea - short and  
simple

Categorize ideas in brainstorming  
session in such a way so as to that  
they fit in one paragraph

→ short sentence (< one breath)

→ when using technical jargons - define them

→ Choose topic → understand each word in sentence in context

→ knowledge

→ points, stats, anecdotes, examples

→ one with which you feel comfortable / gut feeling

→ Brainstorm →

① Jot down points, stats, examples, perspective, quote

② don't be stressed while brainstorming

→ Create a rough outline of essay
